


# Australian Taipan Association & Tanilba Bay Sailing Club NSW 2020-21 State Titles (Take 2) NOTICE OF RACE (NOR) Saturday April 24<sup>th</sup> 2021 (one day only)







# 1. RULES

- 1.1. The series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017 2020 except for changes indicated in relevant paragraphs in this Notice of Race (NoR) and in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing (AS) will apply.
- 1.3. Racing rule 44.1 will be changed as follows:
- 1.4. When a boat may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 of the RRS, she need only take a One-turn penalty. RRS 44 is modified to the extent required by this paragraph.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. All competing boats must be a current financial member of the Australian Taipan association.
- 2.2. All competing boats must have current marine insurance suitable for on water racing.
- 2.3. All competing skippers must have a current YA number.
- 2.4. Divisions:
  - 2.4.1.1. 4.9 cat rigged.
  - 2.4.1.2. 4.9 Sloop rigged.
  - 2.4.1.3. 5.7 Taipan.

# 3. SCHEDULE

# 3.1. Registration:

3.1.1.1. Online at the Taipan Web site or by the "sailor" App prior to 23<sup>rd</sup> of April 2021.

# 3.2. Date of racing:

- 3.2.1.1. Saturday April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021 ONLY.
- 3.2.1.2. Competitors briefing 9.00 am.
- 3.2.1.3. Race sessions 10.00 hrs onwards.
- 3.2.1.4. No starts after 16.30 hrs.

#### 8. SCORING

- 8.1. At least three races are required to be completed (excluding the Invitation/Practice race) to constitute the Regatta race series.
- 8.2. A boat's series score will be calculated as follows:
  - 8.2.1.1. When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
  - 8.2.1.2. When 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
  - 8.2.1.3. When 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

#### 9. SAFETY REGULATIONS

9.1. Competitors must **sign-on** at the beginning of each race day, where races are sailed 'back-to-back', then competitors should sign off at the first available opportunity when they come ashore. The latest time for sign-off will be 1 hour after the last boat finishes a race and comes ashore.

12.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million. Competitors will be asked to provide evidence of this cover at Registration (either Fri evening or Sat morning).
